This is a great chance to hear from Candidates seeking a seat in the Murrumbidgee Electorate at the October 2020 ACT Legislative Assembly Election and to engage with them on local election issues.

The Weston Creek Community Council has outlined a number of issues to Candidates, based on research and consultation with the community over the past 4 years.

Main issues for consideration include:

- accountability for the lack of planning within the district and proper consultation with residents
- a need for renewal of many community facilities including the Weston Creek Community Centre Precinct and a variety of sports facilities
- The requirement for more police presence in the area, namely via a Police Station in either the Molonglo or Weston Creek area.
- Ongoing use of community zoned land for housing and carparks and the removal of green space near residential areas.
